DISAPPEARANCE OF STUDENTS FROM PRESBYTERIAN SECONDARY SCHOOL IN NKWEN, BAMENDA, AMBAZONIA

The Ambazonia Governing Council has seen on social media a video of about eleven persons said to be school children of Presbyterian Secondary School in Nkwen, Bamenda, in the state of Ambazonia under interrogation by some unknown abductors today, November 5, 2018. While the Ambazonia Governing Council investigates the facts of this event, the Council:

1. Recognizes that infiltrators and saboteurs working directly or indirectly for the Cameroun oppressive regime have been planted by Cameroun within the Ambazonia independence cause, and are committing atrocious acts in an attempt to destroy the moral fabric that characterizes our liberation struggle in the national and international scenes;
2. Condemns in the strongest terms any acts of abduction and violence against all innocent civilians;
3. Demands that whoever is keeping these school children should release them immediately;
4. Asks all Ambazonians in the homeland to take all measures as necessary, prioritizing the safety of their lives in every daily activity engagement considering the current state of war in Ambazonia;
5. Iterates that the war Cameroun declared on Ambazonia on November 30, 2017 to maintain its annexation of our territory has provoked and continues to pose significant security threats with national, regional and global consequences, including the killing of the American Baptist Missionary, Charles Wesco by the Cameroun military on October 30, 2018 in Bamenda. Cameroun should cease all aggression of the Ambazonian people and withdraw its troop from Ambazonia, respecting its boundary at its independence on January 1, 1960 in accord with the principle of *Uti Possidetis Juris* upheld by the African Union.
